Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Greetings in the Name of Jesus our Savior!

In the Summer of 2007 I was helping one of my buddies with a project on his farm. We were working in a wooded area which was quite remote, requiring an approximate 15 minute ATV ride to access the spot from our hunting camp. The project required several carefully selected boards which were hemlock, cut to one inch thickness and eight inches in width. We chose the four boards we intended to use because they would not require any cutting with a saw.

As luck would have it, my buddy was drilling a hole into one of the boards but drilled too close to the edge and broke the board. The resulting two pieces were both too small for the intended purpose. One of the remaining three boards was large enough that if cut in half would yield two suitable boards but, alas, we were over a mile from the closest saw! I thought about our dilemma for a moment, picked up the board which was big enough to be cut in half, held it between my hands with the grain running the long way, and then slapped it squarely and sharply against a stout, young three-inch diameter tree next to me.

The loud crack of the board startled my companion and he had an amazed look on his face as I stood in front of him holding two new boards, two halves of the former board split neatly up the middle.

At first he was thinking that I had exhibited some extraordinary feat of strength but then I showed him how I split the board fairly easily because I whacked it against the tree **ALONG THE GRAIN**; you see, when you stress a piece of wood along the grain it is quite vulnerable because the grains cannot work together to resist breakage. This same board would withstand hundreds of pounds of pressure. There was no magic, no trickery, no superior strength – only a fact of nature; i.e. when the grains of wood are tested together they are able to be incredibly strong. When they are tested alone they are incredibly weak!

If you translate this truth from nature into a paradigm for the Church it carries a powerful message. Jane Howard [a writer who lived from 1935-1996] once wrote about us human beings, “Call it a clan, call it a network, call it a tribe, call it a family; whatever you call it, whoever you are, you need one!” Sometimes we don’t call it a clan or network, nor do we call it a tribe or a family; we call it a Church!

I believe I am called to challenge all of you, my brethren in Christ here at Ben Salem U.C.C., to hear and to embrace this truth. You are living through a tremendous time of transition which began over two years ago; for most of you it probably feels like forever. Transitions sometimes are challenging, many times frightening, and always unsettling. This time of transition in the life of your church has been and will continue to be punctuated by a variety of spiritual and emotional hurdles. There is grieving for the pastors [both “called” and “interim”] whom you have known and respected who have served among you and then gone on; there is impatience and frustration you feel when it seems like even God Himself cannot or will not move the process along; there is disappointment and resentment when it looks like a “call” is on the horizon but its not; and as all these things are swirling around you and inside you, there is a prevailing anxious but joyful excitement which causes you to wonder who, by God’s grace and leading, will finally be called to become our next pastor and teacher, and when and how will all that unfold? It’s exhausting just to think about it, isn’t it?

Friends, here is the **Good News** in all this; here is where we discover the miracle of faith which is the Church – not one of you is expected to nor will you be required to hold up the Church and its mission through this time on your own! Ben Salem Church has a long, faithful tradition of being a community, a tribe, a family of faith, where members and friends hear God’s call and respond to that call **TOGETHER**. As you work and journey side-by-side into God’s tomorrow I call you to claim and to rely on the strength of your **togetherness** which is the very presence of God among you and which will in mysterious and marvelous ways continue to empower you to be faithful people of God.

Anxious for you to step into God’s tomorrow **TOGETHER**, I remain, as always...

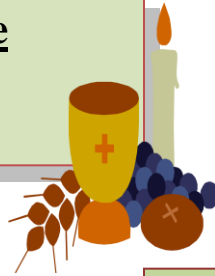

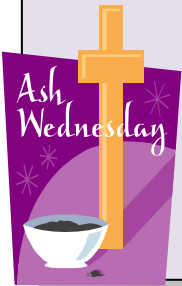

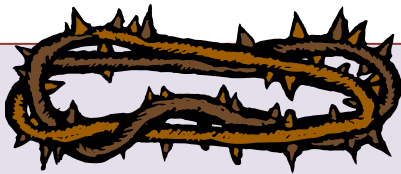
Call to the Annual Congregational Meeting

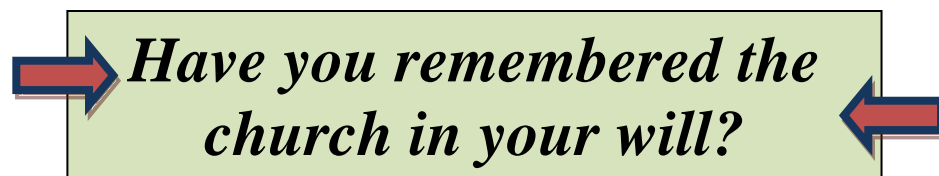

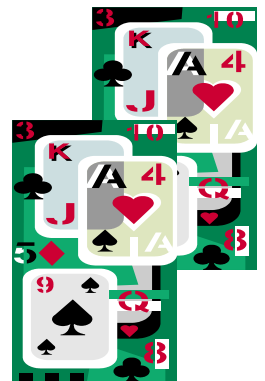

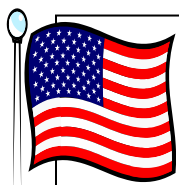
